

<b>Standard of Care – Kitten/Cat Health Protocol</b>	
<b>Consult template = History Template – Puppy/Kitten Vacc OR Annual Vacc Dog/Cat</b>	
<p><b>Vaccination Schedule</b></p> <p><b>Feline Enteritis, Cat Flu (Rhinotracheitis and Calicivirus)</b>  1<sup>st</sup> Vacc – 6-8 weeks – F3  2<sup>nd</sup> Vacc – F3  3<sup>rd</sup> Vacc –F3 final booster  Then annually F3</p> <p><b>Feline Aid Virus (FIV)</b>  <b>3 Injections, each 2 weeks apart, and then annually</b>  Adult cat over 7 months must be blood tested before administering the Vaccination</p>	<p><b>INVOICING</b>  As per Vaccination Schedule</p> <p><b>BIIN – for remainder of vaccination schedule AND desex/chip</b>  <b>BIIN for annual vaccination</b></p>
<p><b>Preventative Care</b>  <b>Fleas AND Worming (spot-on)</b>  <b>We recommend Evicto</b></p>	
<p><b>Preventative Care</b></p> <p><b>Worming (oral)</b>  Endogard (by weight) very 2 weeks until 3 months of age, then 3 monthly (purchase 12 months at a time and get reminders)  Popantol for tapeworm 3 monthly</p>	<p><b>INVOICING</b>  As per Vaccination Schedule</p> <p><b>BIIN – for remainder of vaccination schedule AND desex/chip; book for annual vaccination</b></p>
<p><b>Microchipping</b></p> <p>Must be done by 12 weeks of age in SA (legal requirement). Puppy must also be registered with Dogs and Cats Online</p>	<p><b>INVOICING</b>  <b>Microchip insertion</b>  <b>Ensure chip form is fully completed</b></p>
<p><b>Desexing</b>  SA law requires desexing at 6 months.</p> <p><b>Pre-Sx Exam</b>  Check deciduous teeth  Check for 2 male testes  Discuss Worming and heartworm prevention  Microchipping  Check for Hernias  Discuss Pain relief (if requesting more pain relief than is offered at time of Sx, will be additional cost)</p>	<p><b>INVOICING</b>  As per Desex standard of care</p> <p><b>BIIN – for phone follow-up and revisit as per travel card</b></p>
<p><b>Diet</b>  Generally, we recommend the Advance range, however your Vet may have a reason to suggest a specialised prescription diet, Hills Science Diet or</p>	

Royal Canin foods. Each of these foods offer both wet and dry options.	
<b>Dental</b> Grade 1 dental – book in for scale and polish Grade 2 dental – book in for scale and polish G 3 & 4 – book in for surgical procedure	<b>See Dental standard of care</b>
<b>Ageing Cat</b> Blood tests form age 7 especially if not done previously Annual blood pressure test from age 7	<b>INVOICE</b> <b>Consult (if no consult, then blood taking fee)</b> <b>Blood test fee</b>
