

Standard of Care – Puppy Health Protocol	
Consult template = History Template – Puppy/Kitten Vacc OR Annual Vacc Dog/Cat	
Vaccination Schedule Hepatitis, Distemper, Parvo, Kennel Cough 1 st Vacc – 6-8 weeks – C3+C2i (C2i – canine coronavirus and leptospira) 2 nd Vacc – 12 weeks (C3 + 2 nd C2i booster) PLU Broncoshield (intranasal) 3 rd Vacc – 16 weeks – C3 final booster Then annually C5	INVOICING As per Vaccination Schedule BIIN – for remainder of vaccination schedule AND desex/chip BIIN for annual vaccination
Preventative Care Heartworm (dogs over 7 months must have a heartworm test prior to any treatment) Nexgard Spectra monthly through until desex (6months – therefore purchase 3 month box) At desex, decide if to continue with Nexgard Spectra (6 month box) or Proheart annual injection (will then need to pick up nexgard for fleas/ticks) Worming Endogard (by weight) very 2 weeks until 3 months of age, then 3 monthly (purchase 12 months at a time and get reminders) Popantol for tapeworm 3 monthly Flea/Tick treatment If not using Nexgard Spectra, then use Nexgard chews OR if prefer a spot on – try Frontline.	INVOICING As per Vaccination Schedule BIIN – for remainder of vaccination schedule AND desex/chip; book for annual vaccination
Microchipping Must be done by 12 weeks of age in SA (legal requirement). Puppy must also be registered with Dogs and Cats Online	INVOICING Microchip insertion Ensure chip form is fully completed
Socialisation	

<p>Start doing short walks in non-populated areas 10-14 days after final vaccination.</p>	
<p>Behaviour Discuss any puppy behavioural concerns e.g. biting, toilet training</p>	<p>Refer to ABT 41 Glenroy St, Athol Park SA 5012 0431 301 118</p>
<p>Desexing SA law requires desexing at 6 months. For large breed dogs we can make an exception if owners request. A written exemption letter with a booked desexing date is required. The letter template can be found from consult, print form, delayed desex form</p> <p>Pre-Sx Exam Check deciduous teeth Check for 2 male testes Discuss Dew Claw removal with Owner Discuss Worming and heartworm prevention Microchipping Check for Hernias Discuss Pain relief (if requesting more pain relief than is offered at time of Sx, will be additional cost)</p>	<p>INVOICING As per Desex standard of care</p> <p>BIIN – for phone follow-up and revisit as per travel card</p>
<p>Diet Generally, we recommend the Advance range, however your Vet may have a reason to suggest a specialised prescription diet, Hills Science Diet or Royal Canin foods. Each of these foods offer both wet and dry options.</p>	<p>See Dental standard of care</p>
