

Standard of Care – Vomiting and Diarrhoea	
Consult template = Vomiting and Diarrhoea	
Bill – refer to invoicing (below)	
At time of booking:	
Check if dog is UTD with vaccination; also check age of dog	
If in risk group – advise owner to alert us of arrival and to wait in car. Vet will come to them and undertake Parvo test (advise of the cost of test)	
If +’ve – move to Parvo flowsheet	
<p>If negative</p> <p>Check when wormed last</p> <p>Thorough and detailed physical examination</p> <p>Check if dog is a chewer or able to acquire other than normal foods</p> <p>INPATIENT</p> <p>Hospital admission</p> <p>Diagnostics – REM bloods, x-ray, ultrasound</p> <p>Treat as appropriate – fluid therapy with glucose & VAM, anti-emetics, analgesia, antimicrobials</p> <p>If not vomiting - scourban</p> <p>OUTPATIENT (Discharged)</p> <p>Discharge with Hills I/D or RC gastrointestinal, and equivalent wet, Oralade, probiotics,</p>	<p>INVOICING</p> <p>Consult and Parvo speed test – move to parvo flowchart and invoicing</p> <p>ADMITTED</p> <p>Consult and hospitalisation</p> <p>Hospital admission</p> <p>Fluid therapy</p> <p>Glucose</p> <p>VAM</p> <p>Scourban (if no Vom)</p> <p>Diagnostics</p> <p>Treatments</p> <p>Daily inpatient checks, hospital charges, treatments as per hosp sheet</p> <p>Medical waste disposal</p> <p>Disposables</p> <p>Discharge with home care</p> <p>Nurse callback – post discharge – day 2 and day 4</p> <p>BIIN</p> <p>Revisit 1 week</p>
