<p>Consult Review age, breed, physical condition Assess Gum colour Abdo pain Temp Heart Rate Degree of hydration</p>	<p>Treatment 1.Minor (not dehydrated, good condition) Bright, alert, no history of chewing everything Metamide or Cerenia and GI protectants (peptosyl & probiotics) Scourban if diah or loose motions Home on peptosyl, metamide, and/or A/B, Probiotics, and/or Scourban</p> <p>2.Severe – dehydrated, depressed attitude Blood tests Hospitalisation Cerenia inj Fluids with VAM, Trib, NSAID if approp Start Oralade (approx. 6 hrs) 1ml/kg and/or peptosyl</p> <p>Next step -= no vomiting – Hills ID/Recharge and/or other food as applicable To remain in hospital until has eaten and kept down food</p>	<p>INVOICE Consult Peptosyl Metamide Gastrointestinal Hills I/D or Royal Canin Gastroint until revisit NURSE PHONE: 2 days BIIN: If not fixing</p> <p>INVOICE Consult Hosp. admission Bloods Inpatient check per day Fluid therapy first bag (+extra) Cerenia Trib VAM NSAID Medical waste fee Disposables Oralade Gastrointestinal foods Home products – A/b, etc Nurse Phone: 2 days to review BIIN: 1 week (when antibiotic is stopped) Then introduce probiotic (2 wks) and discuss transition to gastro foods</p>
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
