

Hey team:

Please see the final March Roster. **The new rotating roster will start on April 7<sup>th</sup>.**

I just wanted to let you know about a couple of changes. Please be re-assured that the changes are made to give you guys a breather and make things easier for **you**. My goal with the roster as follows:

- 1- Give the current staff a breather from the hectic February we have had.
- 2- Book patients to the capacity of our current staff levels not our former or future staff levels. That means that we will assume that we have no new staff for the time being and adjust our schedule accordingly when we get new team members.
- 3- Allow time for leave entitlements of current staff.
- 4- Allow time for professional growth and catch-ups.
- 5- Allow time for the proper workup of our medical patients and see emergency appointments as needed.
- 6- Allow time for training new staff. I refuse to have a culture of being 'thrown in the deep end'.

Please let me know by the end of the month if you think the goals above have been met and if you think we need any other goals to ensure proper patient care and job fulfillment for everyone.

To achieve the above goals, we have had to make some changes. The main one is a reduction of workload. Let's try that in March and let me know if it helps or hinders. Your input is VALUABLE. Please speak up if you have any concerns. The roster changes outlined below:

- 1- I have changed slightly the way the roster looks so that I can get my head around which staff is in which role. Please let me know if it doesn't make sense.
- 2- Shifts start at 8.15am not at 8.30am. It has come to our attention that staff were requested to be in clinic 10-15mins before your shift commences. I truly believe in the importance of the morning huddle therefore I want to keep it. However, you should be paid for that time. Therefore, shifts will officially start at 8.15am. That means that some lunch breaks have been adjusted to match the number of hours in your contracts. We are open to adjust the hours in your contracts accordingly. Please do let us know if that's what you'd prefer.
- 3- We are working towards having the Sx vet finish at 4pm with surgeries going from 9am-3pm with a 45min allowance for lunch in the middle and time at the end of the day for medical records, phone calls, and patient recovery. That means that as long as we have enough staff, the sx vet does not see afternoon consults. I think that might reduce the stress of 'having to finish' on time to start consults. Vets please let me know what you think.
- 4- I have added a 'team leader' line. That is the person who oversees the clinic that day. That person (in theory) will not have clinical or reception duties and will focus on supporting the team to get through the day. For now, that role is only filled by Steve or myself.

5- I am working towards having a co-consult nurse for every vet consulting. It's a work in progress. While we get there, there will be times where the consulting vet is working without a nurse. Sorry about that vets. I do know that it's not ideal but in return, we will adjust the schedule to allow you guys to have enough time to type your notes and complete your consults properly.

I think that is the general idea. Please do reach out if something doesn't make sense and with any feedback. As I said, your input is valuable.
